Oncological skull base surgery is conceived for malignant lesions originating in, secondarily infiltrating, or in close proximity to the skull base. The "Symposia and Dissection Course on Oncological Skull Base Surgery" is a series of meetings focused on oncological skull base surgery. The events comprehend an opening symposium on the topic, featuring presentations by experts in the field, followed by a dedicated dissection course. The course includes 2 participants per surgical station for the dissection course (1 anatomical specimen per station). For 10 symposium participants, there will be the opportunity to participate in an observership for the entire duration of the dissection course.

Symposium - Temporal bone resections in advance malignancies of the parotid gland

9:00 AM - 1:30 PM on September 17th, 2025 (Limited spots available)

- Rationale and surgical details of temporo-parotid en-bloc resection
- Surgical and pathological issue of en-bloc procedures
- Role of integrated therapies in a multidisciplinary setting

Dissection Course - En-bloc temporo-parotid resection (en-bloc lateral, en-bloc subtotal)

2:30 PM on September 17th, 2025 to 6:30 PM on September 18th, 2025 (Limited 20 participants and 10 observers)

Each dissection station in the course will preferably pair two participants: one more familiar with head and neck surgery and the other with otologic and otoneurological surgery. The dissection program will also include the time for the cervical and parapharyngeal space procedures related to temporo-parotid resections. Participants will be guided in applying the rationale and executing the procedures through constant tutoring.
